Important Dates, Events & Information

- 1. Parent/Team Meeting: Monday, December 2nd 6 PM in the Staff Cafeteria at OPRF: ALL members of the OPRF Swim and Dive Team and their parents should attend. If you miss Monday evening's meeting, have your swimmer/diver get the handouts. Note: PLEASE BE PREPARED TO PAY SEASON FEES (see last page of this document with expense details and payment options).
- 2. Apparel: The websites for the boys' suits, team shirts and nice-to-haves apparel will launch as soon as possible. It will include apparel for parents so we can show our Huskie pride in the stands. We will be switching to a new vendor for suits (Speedo Endurance). The suit will be the same as last year except for the brand. You do not need to order an new suit this year if your son has an OPRF suit from prior years that still fits. However, you MUST have an OPRF suit to compete. We are trying to gauge how many suits we will need. - 4. Senior Night: We will celebrate our senior swimmers and divers at the Glenbard meet on Friday, January 17th. During a break in the meet, each senior and his parent(s) will be introduced on the pool deck. After the meet, senior swimmers and divers and their families, as well as all freshman, sophomore and junior swimmers/divers, are invited to a dinner immediately following the home meet (held at one of the cafeterias at the high school). Freshman, sophomore and junior swimmers and divers contribute money and a dessert item for the dinner. Your son's contribution (listed in the fees below) covers pizza, decorations, flowers for senior swimmers and diver parents, cake for all to share, and gifts for our seniors.
- 5. End of Season Banquet: After the season is over, we will gather to celebrate the season with a banquet on Tuesday, March 3rd. We will send more details as the date approaches. Fees for the coaches' gifts are included in the list below. Fees for the banquet dinner will be collected 2 weeks prior to the banquet date.

Away Meets

- Food & Snacks: We will be providing a small meal on the evening of the 3 AWAY WEEKNIGHT MEETS ONLY to all swimmers and divers. The meal will consist of a sandwich chips and a drink. The food will be at school by 3:00pm before the team departs to eat before/after the meet. The meal fee of \$25 (total for all 3 meets) will be included in the fees collected at the parent meeting. The dates are **December 13th; January 10th; January 21st**. Your son should also bring his own healthy snacks, along with a re-usable water bottle to all meets.
